

Longevity Stipend at 6, 10 and 15 Years of Service

To be eligible for the longevity stipend the following conditions must apply: Continuous service is based on the bargaining unit member's continuous years of employment under the administrative jurisdiction of the Sheriff's Office. This may include years of service as a Corrections Officer, if applicable. County service in departments other than the Sheriff's Office is not applicable. The employees must have completed the appropriate years of continuous service the the Sheriff's Office on or before December 1st. The payment is made in a lump sum in early December.

After six (6) years of continuous service, the bargaining unit member is eligible for \$1,000.00.

After ten (10) years of continuous service, the bargaining unit member is eligible for \$1,000.00.

After fifteen (15) years of continuous service, the bargaining unit member is eligible for \$2,000.00.
